**Interim CAO Pedro Carrillo Reports On Further City
Action To Restore Public Confidence in Bell**

Mayor and Vice Mayor agree to finish off their terms without pay

CITY OF BELL, CA JULY 27, 2010 – Interim Chief Administrative Officer Pedro Carrillo announced today that Bell City Council members agreed unanimously on Monday night to take further actions to restore the public's trust in Bell:

- The City Council voted to reduce their salaries by 90-100 percent ensuring that all council members are paid the same;
 - Mayor Oscar Hernandez agreed to cut his pay 100 percent
 - Vice Mayor Teresa Jacobo agreed to cut her pay 100 percent
- The City Council directed staff to conduct an independent investigation of the contracts/with reference to the 3 resigned administrators;
- The City Council pledged to continue to cooperate with the State Attorney General's office and the District Attorney's Office.
